





INSTALLATION GUIDELINES IN DIFFERENT HEIGHTS


Installation guidelines following a**84**" alignment need to have a standard wall cabinet height of**30**", leaving**54**" off the floor, with 36" height for the base, including thetoekick, countertop, and 18" of clearance between the countertop and wall cabinet. This guidelinesuggests that the pantry, oven cabinets, and other similar items be a total height of 84".

Installation guidelines following a**90**" alignment need to have a standard wall cabinet height of **36**", leaving **54**" off the floor, with 36" height for the base, including thetoekick, countertop, and 18" of clearance between the countertop and wall cabinet. This guidelinesuggests that the pantry, oven cabinets, and other similar items be a total height of 90".


Installation guidelines following a**96**" alignment need to have a standard wall cabinet height of**42**", leaving**54**" off the floor, with 36" height for the base, including thetoekick, countertop, and 18" of clearance between the countertop and wall cabinet. This guidelinesuggests that the pantry, oven cabinets and other similar items be a total height of 96".

PRODUCTION

Q: What is the method of assembly?

A: Our cabinets are RTA -Frameless.

Q: Do any of your cabinets contain any particleboard?

A: Our frameless cabinets are fabricated with either Domestic White Maple plywood or Imported plywood. They are 4-way plywood and the finishes are attached on the outside of the box. For the panels, we work with melamine finish or MDF. Both are from high-quality and reputable suppliers.

Q: What kind of drawers do you provide?

A: Our frameless boxes are made with 3/4" plywood bottoms, backs and sides. We work with BLUM soft closing glides.

Q: How does the interior of the cabinet look?

A: Our cabinets will have the plywood look inside, and will be finished with edge banding 4-sided for the highest quality.

Q: Are finished panels necessary for exposed Cabinet ends?

A: Yes. In order to provide you with more finishing options, panels will be needed for exposed sides.

Q: Are products CARB2 certified?

A: Yes, it is our mission to work with suppliers that take pride in making the world a better place, therefore our products are certified.

Q: What are the depths for your cabinets?

A: We follow standard measurements, therefore providing bases 24" deep, vanities 21" deep and wall cabinets 12" deep. In the near future, we will also offer wall cabinets in 24" deep.

Q: What do the shelves look like?

A: Shelves are made from the same plywood material as the boxes, so they will have the same white maple color variation. Shelves are 3/4" thick and are adjustable for better customization. Wall cabinets include 2 shelves and base cabinets include 1 shelf. If cabinets are 42" in height, they will come with 3 shelves, not 2. Additional shelves are available for purchase.

Q: Are the cabinets able to support countertops such as granite or solid surfaces?

A: Yes! Our boxes are made 4-way around with plywood and 3/4" thick material to ensure major resistance without the need to install reinforcements.

Q: Are soft closing mechanisms included?

A: Yes. All of our cabinetsincludea soft closing extension for doors and drawers

Q: What is the warranty for your products?

A: We offer 5 year normal wear and tear warranty on our frameless line.

PLACING ORDERS

Q: Do you work with credit terms?

A: We are currently not working with credit terms nor any sort of NET terms. Orders must be paid 50% upon order placing and the remaining 50% paid prior to pick-up or scheduled delivery.

Q: What payment forms are accepted?

A: We work with most major credit cards such as MasterCard, VISA, and Discover. We also accept checks.

Q: What is the timeline for stock items?

A: Our cabinets will take anywhere between 3 to 10 days to produce, with most orders being in stock already. If an item is delayed due to material, the customer will be notified prior to the beginning of production.

Q: What does it mean to become a dealer?

A: When you sign up to become a dealer, you establish an account with us, and can upsell our products to your clients!

Q: How do I become a dealer?

A: Talk to your sales rep, fill out the Dealer Application and get approved!

PLACING ORDERS

Q: What are the delivery options?

A: We can deliver; however, delivery is not included. Delivery charges are extra. We also offer pickup.

Q: What is the return policy?

A: Our return policy is that if you ordered assembled pieces we cannot accept these returns, however if you buy from us not pre-assembled and they are still in the box upon time of return we will be able to happily accept your returns. But we do not accept returns once the boxes have been opened or damaged.

Q: Are dealers charged sales tax on their orders?

A: At the time of the order, dealers must present their resale or tax exemption certificate to your sales rep to waive sales tax on their orders.
